



We're excited to announce the Christian Life Center Drive-In!

For at least the next few weeks, we'll be hosting the Christian Life Center Drive-In. We know there are a lot of questions, and we've done our best to answer some of the most common ones below.

Also, there are significant complications facing our church family and community as it relates to Covid-19. Therefore, please understand that your participation in this Drive-In Church Service indicates you are willing to fully comply with all of the instructions below.

Please know that if you decide you cannot participate we understand and fully support your decision.

What do you mean by "drive-in?"

Great question, since this isn't anything CLC has ever done before. In accordance with state guidelines, CLC has decided to hold drive-in services on site. For us, that means people will drive onto our campus, park in our parking lot, and experience our Sunday morning service from the comfort of their cars, vans, trucks, or lawn chairs.

Our band will be live on The Showmobile Stage—near the KidZone Entrance. We will also be preaching live from the stage.

What time does it start?

Our drive-in service will begin at 10:30 a.m.

What time does the parking lot open?

The parking lot will open at 9:45 a.m.

Where do we need to park?

When you arrive on campus, our team will direct you to all open spots. We ask that all people enter through the Lewisville Road Entrance. Please follow our team's direction for where to park—for your safety and ours. When you enter, you will notice check-in tents at the entrance of the parking lot. Please pull up to the tent and check-in. If you are planning on staying in your cars, please use the left lane and check in. If you plan on sitting in lawn chairs, please use the right lane and check in.

Do we have to stay in our cars? Can we bring chairs?

Each vehicle will be limited to one parking spot. You are welcome to roll down your windows and participate from the comfort of your vehicle or you will be able to set up chairs in the designated (and socially distanced) area up front. If you decide you'd like to sit in your own chairs, you'll be asked to park in a designated area, wear a mask, and bring your chairs to a designated spot near the stage. We ask that you observe all local guidelines regarding physical distancing as we seek to create safe environment for everyone who attends.

We know that you'll want to see, talk to, and hug one another. However, it is critical that you stay with your household, provide supervision to your children, and stay socially distanced at all times.

How will we hear what's going on?

You'll have two different options to listen and follow along. First, roll down your windows, sit in your lawn chair, and sing along! We'll have outdoor sound equipment so you can sing along as loud as you want with the windows down... just like you do driving around town. Your other option is to tune on your car's radio and you'll be able to listen from the comfort of your car that way too! **Please tune your radio dial to 104.1 FM.**

Will bathrooms be open?

Yes, the bathrooms through the main entrance will be open. Please follow the signs, wear a mask, and maintain social distance. We'd recommend you use the bathroom prior to leaving your home.

What time will it end?

Our service will aim to end at 11:30 a.m.

Will you be serving coffee?

For the next few weeks, we are trying to determine the best way to gather together in a way that honors our state guidelines and the needs of our most vulnerable. Therefore, for now, we will not be serving coffee. However, you should definitely pack your car with great concessions to enjoy during the Drive-In Service!

What about communion?

We have communion the first Sunday of every month. You will be given communion supplies when you enter parking lot underneath the welcome tents.

Will I be able to leave before it is over?

For the safety of our team, fellow attendees, and everyone on campus, we ask that once you are parked that you do not leave. However, if there is an emergency that requires you to leave, please find one of our Guest Services volunteers to help you exit safely.

On normal Sundays there's a lot of traffic. What should we expect this Sunday?

We are working on plans to help make the arriving and leaving processes as smooth and quick as possible; however, please anticipate delays as you are entering and exiting. Please be patient with our team, your fellow attendees, and our staff as they work to get you parked and exited as quickly and safely as possible.

Can my kids come, too?

We would love for them to join you! In fact, our Preschool and Elementary staff have been pulling together some tips & tricks for you to have a great drive-in experience!.

- Our KidZone Staff have prepared a packet to help your kids enjoy and participate in the Worship Service. Please pull up to the 2nd tent marked KidZone Materials.
- Pastor Josh has committed to keeping his sermon shorter and include visual aids that will be engaging for your kids.

Will the service still be online/live-streamed?

Yes! We understand not everyone is able to make it out. So we will be continue live-streaming our services at 5pm on Saturday and 9&10:45 am on Sunday. In the next few weeks, we plan to add an option to view the Drive-In Service online as well.
